The Adjudicators

Vocal, Pianoforte & Instrumental

Donal McCrisken MBE, MA, BMus, MTD, LTCL, Adv Cert Ed will adjudicate the Vocal, Piano and Instrumental sections. Donal is a Belfast-based musician with many years of experience as a pianist, accompanist, conductor, examiner and adjudicator. Donal was conductor of Cappella Caeciliana from January 1999 until his retirement from the choir in November 2021. Under his direction Cappella gave concerts all over Northern Ireland, in Dublin, Scotland, Germany, Austria, Switzerland, Italy and the USA. The choir has recorded five highly successful CDs and has broadcast frequently on BBC Radio 4, Radio Ulster and RTE. Donal was for six years, 2005 – 2011, head of music in St Malachy's College, Belfast - Northern Ireland's first specialist music school, whose students he led in concert tours to Washington DC, Philadelphia, England and Rome. A qualified British and International Federation of Festivals adjudicator, Donal has adjudicated festivals throughout Northern Ireland, Republic of Ireland and the UK. In 2020, Donal was awarded the MBE for services to music, education and crosscommunity relations.

Traditional

Gráinne Meyer will adjudicate the Traditional classes. County Antrim based harpist Gráinne Meyer is the most recent winner of the "World Music Competition" following performances at Wales International Harp Festival 2023. Gráinne studied at the TU Dublin conservatoire of music after completing an honours music degree from the University of York, where she was awarded the Thomas Beecham scholarship for performance. As a performer and teacher, Gráinne leads a diverse and busy schedule across Ireland and beyond. As a composer, Gráinne's arrangements are regularly performed by both soloists and ensembles, some of which have recently been featured on prominent platforms such as BBC Radio, Classic FM and RTÉ.

Guitar & Vocals

David Hawthorne will adjudicate the Guitar classes and Vocal Classes on Thursday evening. He is an international examiner with RSL Awards (Rockschool) and has examined a variety of instruments and formats including contemporary and classical piano, guitar, drums, vocals, bass and ukulele, along with music production based performance. He has examined in China, India, Singapore and Central Europe, along with work in the UK and Ireland. He is a lecturer in Belfast Metropolitan College and has conducted brass bands in NI. He has provided adjudication for group ensembles including rock bands, string quartets and choirs.

Larne Music Festival - Child Protection Policy:

Festival Environment

It is the policy of our Festival to inform and involve parents, guardians, carers and teachers in partnership with the Festival in order to ensure, as far as it is reasonably practical, a safe environment at our Festival. However it must be stressed that responsibility for children under 18 years of age and vulnerable adults (those with learning difficulties) rests with parents, guardians, carers, teachers – not with Festival staff. All suspicions and allegations of abuse will be taken seriously, responded to swiftly and appropriately and the Festival's Organising Committee and Volunteers have a responsibility to report concerns, contacting external agencies as necessary.

Festival Personnel

For both Members of the Executive Committee of Larne Musical Festival Association and appointed volunteers, all names, addresses and phone numbers are kept on file. All will wear official badges at the festival to identify them clearly. Anyone wearing a badge may be approached and will report your concerns to Mrs. Marie Barnes (Larne Music Festival Child Protection Officer). All concerns and problems will be taken seriously, discussed in a private area provided and documented and dated. Issues raised will be addressed by the safeguarding team.

Attendance at the Festival

This Policy is shared with all parents, guardians, carers, teachers and schools who then become partners in implementing this Policy. It is the responsibility of parents, guardians, teachers and carers to ensure that children and vulnerable adults are supervised at all times.

Performance Area and Changing Areas

As the Festival is held in a public area, parents, guardians, carers and teachers are reminded that children and vulnerable adults must be supervised at all times including while they are in public areas e.g. Toilets and Practice Rooms. We are unable to provide changing facilities.

Photographs, Video recording and Press Photography

The Executive Committee bans the taking of photographs and videos during the Festival. Photographs may be taken by local press, provided they have obtained permission from those with parental responsibility. Photographs by Accredited Photographers will be released to the media and may be used on the Festival Webpages and Social Media.
