# The Adjudicators

## Pianoforte & Instrumental

**Darren Day** will adjudicate the Piano & Instrumental classes. Darren is an accomplished musician, educator, examiner and adjudicator with a diverse career spanning performance, teaching and music direction. He holds a BMUS (Hons) degree specialising in Voice, Oboe, and Piano from UUU, and an LTCL from Trinity College London. Darren has extensive experience teaching students from beginner to diploma level and is committed to nurturing talent at all ages. His work includes accompanist, arranger, conductor, music director, singer and composer with piano books available through Amazon and 80 Days Publishing. As a Music and Diploma Examiner for Trinity College London, Darren has examined across the UK, India, and Sri Lanka.

## Vocal – Junior

**Sheelagh Greer BEM** will adjudicate the Junior Vocal classes. Sheelagh is a local well-known Mezzo Soprano and Pianist who graduated from Queens University Belfast with a music degree specialising in vocal performance. Along with being a busy soloist, Sheelagh also founded and conducts The Clare Chorale, is Conductor of the Ballyclare Male Choir, the Pro Bono Law Choir, organist of Ballynure Methodist Church and a singer with NI Opera and The Ulster Consort. She was the presenter of BBC Radio Ulster's programme, 'Showstoppers' and was adjudicator for the BBC School Soloist of the Year. Sheelagh was awarded a BEM in the King's Birthday Honours in 2024 for Services to Music in Northern Ireland.

## Vocal – Senior

**Melanie Topley** will adjudicate the Senior Vocal classes. Melanie graduated from Queens University with a BA (Hons) in Music and English and an MA in Opera Studies before completing her PGCE in Music and LLCM Diploma in Classical Singing. Melanie is a vastly experienced vocal tutor, in both Classical and Musical Theatre, with her students having success in festivals across the province and in examinations. She previously worked as a music teacher and as Head of Music, during which time she was Musical Director of a number of Musicals, all of which were placed in the Annual Schools Art Competition (Secondary School Drama Prize) and on three occasions, achieved 1st prize. She is an accredited Vocal Health First Aider and Vocal Habilitation Professional. She has been part of the chorus of NI Opera and its Chorus Development Programme, performing in Tosca (2023) and Eugene Onégin (2024).

## **Vocal – Pop (Senior)**

**Eve Williams** will adjudicate the Senior Pop Vocal classes. Eve is a published, award-winning singer and songwriter and holds a Master of Music in Songwriting. She is also a qualified singing teacher, teaching all ages, abilities and genre who has taught singing, songwriting, piano and music theory since 2005. She has worked with stars of *The X Factor UK* and *The Voice Norway* and specialises in helping singers find their voice and develop their potential. She also helps beginner and aspiring songwriters to refine their craft and reach their musical goals, whether the aim is to pursue music professionally, sing/write for personal development or for fun.

## **Vocal – Adult Choirs**

**Edward Craig** will adjudicate the Adult Choir classes. Edward is a Northern Irish choral director and educator with a passion for inclusivity and bringing people together through music. Graduating with a Bachelor of Music and a Master of Arts from Queen's University Belfast, he also holds the Royal College of Organists Diploma in Choral Directing. For over twenty years he has served as Head of the vibrant Music Department at Carrickfergus Grammar School. In 1993, Edward founded Grosvenor Chorale, a mixed-voice choir based in Belfast, which he continues to conduct. Under his direction, both his children and adult ensembles have earned widespread critical acclaim and a loyal following across Northern Ireland and beyond — and through this work, he has helped countless singers discover the joy of choral music.

## **Traditional**

**Gráinne Meyer** will adjudicate the Traditional classes. Gráinne is a Belfast based harpist and composer and is the most recent winner of the World Music Competition following performances at Wales International Harp Festival 2023. Gráinne studied at the University of York, where she received the Thomas Beecham Scholarship, before completing postgraduate training in classical and Irish traditional music at the TU Dublin Conservatoire. She has worked with the Ulster Orchestra, Ulster Consort, recorded for BBC and RTÉ, and maintains an active profile as a soloist and educator. She is currently completing a PhD at Queen's University, exploring how emerging music technologies can support accessible performance for disabled musicians.

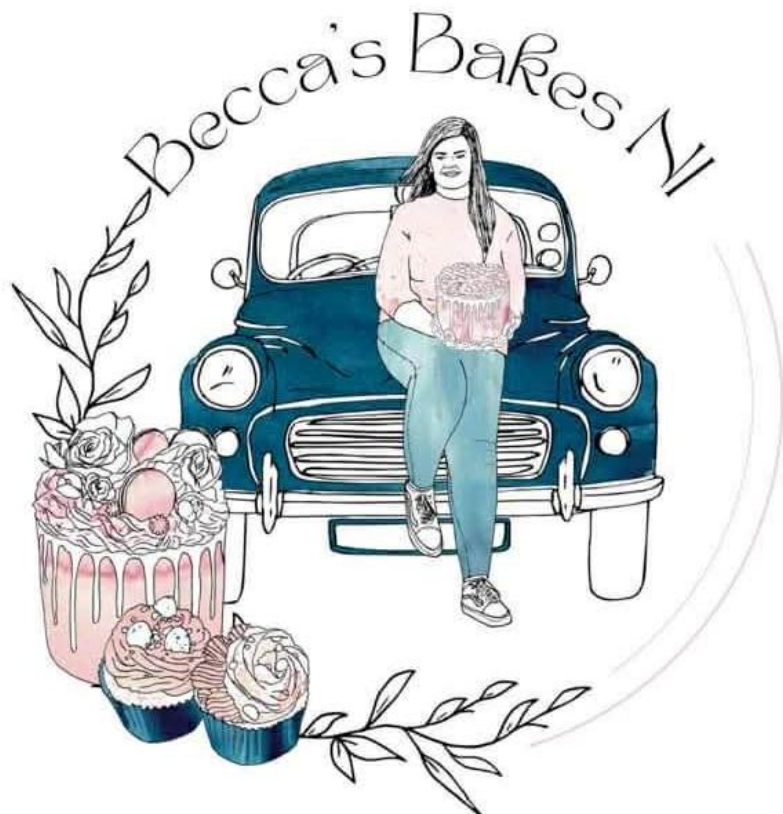

# Child Protection Policy

## **Festival Environment**

It is the policy of our Festival to inform and involve parents, guardians, carers and teachers in partnership with the Festival in order to ensure, as far as it is reasonably practical, a safe environment at our Festival. However it must be stressed that responsibility for children under 18 years of age and vulnerable adults (those with learning difficulties) rests with parents, guardians, carers, teachers – not with Festival staff. All suspicions and allegations of abuse will be taken seriously, responded to swiftly and appropriately and the Festival's Organising Committee and Volunteers have a responsibility to report concerns, contacting external agencies as necessary.

## **Festival Personnel**

For both Members of the Executive Committee of Larne Musical Festival Association and appointed volunteers, all names, addresses and phone numbers are kept on file. All will wear official badges at the festival to identify them clearly. Anyone wearing a badge may be approached and will report your concerns to Mrs. Marie Barnes (Larne Music Festival Child Protection Officer). All concerns and problems will be taken seriously, discussed in a private area provided and documented and dated. Issues raised will be addressed by the safeguarding team.

## **Attendance at the Festival**

This Policy is shared with all parents, guardians, carers, teachers and schools who then become partners in implementing this Policy. It is the responsibility of parents, guardians, teachers and carers to ensure that children and vulnerable adults are supervised at all times.

## **Performance Area and Changing Areas**

As the Festival is held in a public area, parents, guardians, carers and teachers are reminded that children and vulnerable adults must be supervised at all times including while they are in public areas e.g. Toilets and Practice Rooms. We are unable to provide changing facilities.

## **Photographs, Video recording and Press Photography**

The Executive Committee bans the taking of photographs and videos during the Festival. Photographs may be taken by local press, provided they have obtained permission from those with parental responsibility. Photographs by Accredited Photographers will be released to the media and may be used on the Festival Webpages and Social Media.
